Suitable for the application in dry, damp and wet rooms and also for laying on, in and under plaster as well as in concrete and masonry excluding in direct laying in shaken or stamped concrete, not suitable for imbedding in solidified or compressed concrete. Copper screening offers increased electromagnetic compatibility and disturbance-free transmission of signals and impulses.</p>
